- The BTAC regular meeting was called to order at the Boulder City Hall at 8:02 a.m. by Terry Minow. 15 individuals attended.
- A motion to approve the February meeting minutes was made, seconded and passed.
- Information provided from area leaders and organizations:
 - Chamber. Finalizing the phone book. Received the SWMT grant to improve Chamber website.
 - Boulder Schools. OPI tour planned for literacy grant. Enrollment up by 30 at high school.
 - City of Boulder. Commerce development fund contract is progressing. Short two police officers. Earnest money for parking area across from the city park has been paid.
 - Faith Group Support. Helping with donations to assist Blackfeet with snow removal challenges.
 - Elkhorn Foundation. New grant cycle is opening.
 - Jefferson County Commission. Fish pond development moving forward. Snow removal in progress.
 - County Events. SWMT grant for website development is in progress. Fall fiddle event planned for Basin.
 - MDC. Eleven workforce reductions will be finalized March 30th.
 - JLDC. Working on new building and infrastructure upgrades in tax districts. Wind developer coordination is ongoing. Researching building demolition on the South Campus. Crowd funding class was very informative. Business class in MT City was productive.
