Meeting Minutes

October 2021 minutes were approved with two corrections.

Meeting started with introductions. Information provided from area leadership and organizations:

- **Chamber** – Holiday events scheduled for late November. Chamber membership renewals will be going out.
- **Boulder Schools** – Bond levy passed by voters. Next steps include working with bond counsel and other planning activities. Playoffs for fall sports is happening. Trade fair is scheduled for students. Working with Highway Patrol on signage.
- **City of Boulder** – New subdivision has been approved and is moving forward. Water well improvements are taking place. The City of Boulder is interviewing for a code enforcer. Town Pump project is moving ahead.
- **Faith Group** – Large turnout for Halloween event.
- **Elkhorn Community Foundation** – Donation requests letters should be ready by mid-November.
- **Jefferson County Commission** – Developer has reached out to the County regarding the availability of a parcel near the firehouse. The County is moving forward on the MT Tunnels tax deed process.
- **County Events** – Halloween events were successful throughout the County. Wedding requests are coming in for the 2022 season.
- **IBC** – No report.

- **JLDC** – Childcare Coordinator has been hired. South Campus project is moving forward and a public hearing is scheduled for November 18th. Golden Sunlight Mine is ramping up activating near Whitehall. Working with Ashgrove in the North County.

- **MHP** – Sgt. Nelson sent a Drew an update. The advance training academy is scheduled to start in January.

- **Boulder Childcare** – Drew shared a memo from the BCCWG. A name for the new non-profit has been selected. Building update – foundation is in place and the building should be in place by end of the year.
- **County Health Department** – An AmeriCorps worker has been brought on and that person will help with the CHIP. Vaccination clinics are being scheduled. Implementing WIC throughout the County is ongoing.
- **Marketing Committee** – Recently presented to the City Council. Looking for funding for projects.

Public Comment – Barb Reiter – animal shelter is continuing to fundraise. More spay/neuter clinics are being scheduled. Connie Grenz – Boulder fitness club is open at the bottom of the Methodist Church. Tim Norbeck – school district is continuing to work with YDI on partnership opportunities.
